

How to find us.....

From Central Contra Costa County:

Highway 24 East to 680 North, Highway 680 North to Highway 242, Grant Street off ramp. Turn right onto Grant Street (Grant Street becomes East Street in the general area of John Muir Hospital/Concord Campus, formerly Mt. Diablo Hospital). Left on Bonifacio then immediately turn left into the parking garage.

From East Contra Costa County (Pittsburg/Antioch):

Highway 4 West toward Martinez to Highway 242 South, Grant Street off ramp. Turn left at the stoplight onto Grant Street (Grant Street becomes East Street in the general area of John Muir Hospital/Concord Campus, formerly Mt. Diablo Hospital). Left on Bonifacio then immediately turn left into the parking garage.

From Solano County (Benicia/Vallejo):

Across Benicia Bridge – 680 South to Highway 4 East (towards Antioch), Highway 4 East to Highway 242 South, Grant Street off ramp. Turn left at the stoplight onto Grant Street (Grant Street becomes East Street in the general area of John Muir Hospital/Concord Campus, formerly Mt. Diablo Hospital). Left on Bonifacio then immediately turn left into the parking garage.

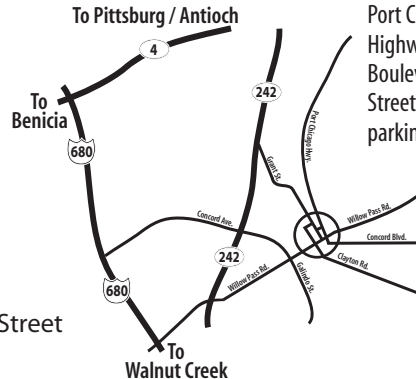
Walking Directions From BART (Concord Terminal)

Leaving the BART station, walk onto Oakland Avenue and walk past the parking garage entrance. Cross Clayton Road at the traffic light and turn left (CVS/Pharmacy drug store should be on your right with the BART tracks overhead). Clayton Road will turn into Port Chicago Highway. The BART tracks will always be in view. Continue on Port Chicago Highway for approximately 6 short blocks. You will cross Sunset Avenue, Concord Boulevard, Willow Pass Road, Salvio Street and Pacheco Street. Turn left onto Bonifacio Street. We are on the corner of Bonifacio and East Street. Walk through our building parking garage to the elevator and we are on the 3rd floor, suite 350.
